#### **Know the Words**

Think of your favorite song. I bet you know the words by heart. And then there are other songs. You know the ones. The songs that you really like the tune and would give it a 10 on Dick Clark's America's Bandstand back in the day. A great beat that you can really dance to it! But when you stop and really look at the lyrics, the meaning of the song is totally different or deeper than what you originally thought.



This weekend we celebrate the Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary. The Gospel reading has that beautiful song, or canticle, from Mary that has affectionately been dubbed The Magnificat throughout the centuries. Every day the Magnificat is prayed by priests, deacons, religious, and anyone who wants to join in the Divine Office—the universal prayers of the Church on a daily basis. The close of the Evening Prayer is the Magnificat. So it is prayed a lot! But how well do you know the words? Or perhaps you have even recited the words but have never truly reflected upon them.

Mary begins so humbly, with the words: "My soul proclaims the greatness of the Lord; my spirit rejoices in God my Savior." But then, after a few more lines, this young woman, probably 14 years old, gets bold and foretells what God has done and will do: "God has shown the strength of God's arm, and has scattered the proud in their conceit. God has cast down the mighty from their thrones and has lifted up the lowly. God has filled the hungry with good things, and the rich God has sent away empty." These do not seem to be the words of a meek, humble little girl from the backwater town of Nazareth. These seem to be the words of one who has been filled with the Spirit and provided with prophetic words that challenged the people of her time and continues to challenge us today. How well do we know this tune? How does it challenge us to reach out to our neighbor and help in the ministry of "lifting up the lowly" and "filling the hungry with good things?"

This past month, we've had many opportunities. Grandparents "filled up their grandchildren" with some incredible quality time, activities, and conversation at the Grandparents and Grandchildren Retreat. Numerous volunteers provided food and conversation with the hungry of our community through the StreetLights Outreach Block Parties hosted at VT Pride Park on Imperial Lane and Seymour Park on Green Bay's Westside.
